### Isle of the Dead

The Isle of the Dead holds the stories of many of the people of Port Arthur.

On this 40 minute tour, you'll journey to the island aboard the MV Marana, and take a guided walking tour of the island.

As the sun sets, come out to the dark grounds of the Port Arthur Historic Site for your 90 minute, lantern-lit Ghost Tour.
