

PORT ARTHUR HISTORIC SITE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY (PAHSMA)

TASMAN COUNCIL RATEPAYER & RESIDENT PASS (R&R Pass)

1. THE R&R PASS EXPLAINED:
 - a. Ratepayers and residents of the Tasman Municipality are eligible for a Port Arthur Historic Site R&R Pass
 - b. One R&R Pass will be issued per property, except where the property is rented out and the ratepayer's residential address is not in Tasman. In which case a R&R Pass can be issued for both the residents and ratepayers.
 - c. A pass will be issued in the name of all entitled adult ratepayers or residents and will also be valid for up to 6 children per R&R Pass. Definition of children is between the ages of 7 to 17 years, children under 7 years have free entry.
 - d. Passes are valid for 3 years from date of issue and need to be renewed.
2. HOW TO APPLY FOR R&R PASS:
 - a. An R&R Pass must be applied for in person at the Port Arthur Historic Site Visitor Centre, and requires proof that the applicant is a ratepayer or resident.
3. HOW TO USE THE R&R PASS:
 - a. When visiting the Site R&R Pass holders are asked to go to the Ticketing desk using the pre-paid queue for priority service. The R&R Pass will need to be presented to staff along with photographic ID such as a Driver License for all adults named on the R&R Pass who are entering the Site. No ID is required for children. (Many of our staff do not know local community members by sight and for reporting purposes PAHSMA is required to tally everyone who enters the Site.)
 - b. The R&R Pass will be issued attached to a lanyard, which may be worn when on Site. However, a daily entry lanyard will be provided at the ticketing desk on the day of entry. The daily entry lanyard must be worn while on Site. To clarify, R&R Pass holders must wear the daily entry lanyard while on Site and may choose to also wear the R&R pass on a lanyard.
 - c. R&R Pass holders are required to abide by the Terms and Conditions of entry as shown on the Port Arthur Historic Site website <https://portarthur.org.au/tours/conditions-ticket-purchase-entry/>. The R&R Pass is a privilege and can be withdrawn by PAHSMA.
4. BENEFITS INCLUDED:
 - a. The Introductory Walking Tour
 - b. The Harbour Cruise
 - c. 10% discount on items from the gift shop
 - d. 10% discount on food and beverages from the cafes and *1830 Restaurant and Bar* (excluding alcohol purchases).
 - e. Up to 4 adults per property/R&R Pass, who are not named on the Pass, are permitted a 50% discount on the entry fee when entering with the R&R Pass holder/s.
 - f. Inclusion on our regular electronic news mail out.

- g. Pedestrian access to Point Puer (not a guided tour) – the R&R pass and lanyard must be worn while at Point Puer.
5. WHAT IS *NOT* INCLUDED:
- a. Free access to paid tours.
 - b. Free entry for adults who do not live in the Tasman Municipality, other than as per point 4(e).
 - c. Free access to special events if a separate fee or ticket is applicable for the event.
 - d. Access to the Port Arthur Historic Site without a lanyard of the day except if the pass holder is entering from one of the walking tracks and only transiting the Site. However the R&R Pass must be worn and photographic ID must be carried and presented to a staff member on request.
