About Port Arthur Historic Site

Port Arthur Historic Site is an iconic destination and makes up one of the 11 World Heritage Australian Convict Sites. It operated as a convict punishment station between 1830-1877, with some 7,500 convict men imprisoned. It was known as Hell on Earth, but today you'll find it's spectacularly beautiful. Explore the historical buildings, ruins and heritage gardens set amidst 100 acres of stunning landscapes.

Port Arthur offers a range of family-friendly tours every day:

- Convict Tour: An overview of Port Arthur's history (45 minutes)
- Commandant's Tour: A deeper dive into the history and the site itself (90 minutes)
- Escape from Port Arthur Tour: Hear stories of the lengths convicts would go to escape this prison. (60 minutes)
- Isle of the Dead Cemetery Tour: A visit to the unique island cemetery where around 1100 people are buried.
 (40 minutes)

Evening experiences at Port Arthur:

- Ghost Tour: Port Arthur is one of Australia's most haunted sites. Visit locations and hear stories of these haunting after dark. (90 minutes)
- Fine Dining: 1830 Restaurant and Bar provides a stunning view of the Penitentiary and bay. The menu uses fresh seasonal produce sourced from local growers and producers. Our menu is designed to be shared.

Premium experiences:

• Wheel of Fate: A 4-hour VIP experience, delivering exclusive access to explore life in this infamous prison settlement. With a personal tour guide you will explore buildings that are off limits to regular visitors, before your two-course meal is served within an exclusive building by your personal chef. Private groups only of 2 to 10 persons.

Catering options:

At Port Arthur our café and restaurant provide dining options for FIT and group visitors all day. With pre-bookings (more than 48 hours notice required) the following options are available for all agents:

- **Picnic packages**: Lunch or morning tea packages served in one of our dining or function spaces, or taken for a picnic onsite.
- Group dining: Buffet style lunch or dinners prepared by our chef. Minimum 15 PAX.
- Restaurant dining: Book your group into our 1830 Restaurant for a fine dining experience. Menu ordering or set menu availability.
