

Port Arthur Historic Site - Investing in the Future



Port Arthur is Australia's largest and most intact convict settlement. The stories and historic fabric of the UNESCO World Heritage listed site are fundamental to understanding Australia's colonial past, reflecting on our national identity and informing our future.

For over 30 years the Port Arthur Historic Site Management Authority (PAHSMA) has been conserving and caring for the buildings, collections and landscape of Port Arthur, ensuring they remain accessible and sharing their stories with the world.

Conserving the site is not only important for the protection of the invaluable history, it is also a requirement under the World Heritage Convention. To ensure we can continue to invest appropriately in our important conservation works and to meet our UNESCO obligations, PAHSMA is changing the entry ticket pricing for Port Arthur from July 1 2025.

Site Entry Tickets from 1 July 2025:
